



## ZEO Reactor

### Installation Guide

Please open the package carefully and check for damaged or lost parts.

### Parts Included

- (1) Main ZEO reactor body and lid
- (2) ZEO reactor internal body and lid
- (3) Outlet tube and elbow
- (4) Sicce Syncra pump
- (5) Rubber Feet

### Assembling The Main Unit

1. Install rubber feet on to the main ZEO reactor and pump base.
2. Pour ZEOLite media into the internal body chamber: do not overfill the chamber.
3. Connect the outlet tube and elbow to the main reactor body.
4. Connect the outlet of the pump to the main reactor body.

### Select A Suitable Place To Set Your Media Reactor.

1. Verify that your sump has adequate space for the ZEO reactor. Be sure that the ZEO reactor sits flat and is not touching the sides of the sump, any baffles, or any plumbing, which will ensure the quietest operation from your ZEO reactor
2. The pump must be completely submerged underwater when in use.

### To Start

1. Plug in the pump
2. Adjust the flow control with the input control dial on the Sicce pump. The maximum flow rate for most ZEOLite media is 100 gallons per hour. Other products may have different flow requirements so be sure to read the product instructions carefully.
3. Agitate the ZEOLite media daily by pumping the handle on the reactor up and down several times. Thanks to its dual-chamber design, agitating the media is a cinch.

## Recommendations

1. While we take great care to keep any contaminants away from our products during assembly, please take a moment to clean the reactor and plumbing before attaching to your tank. Only clean your reactor with warm water. Never clean acrylic with alcohol based products. Use caution when handling as acrylic scratches easily.
2. Regular maintenance of the pump will ensure a long life and maximum performance.
